## **Travel Notes:**

- We will meet at the departing airport. You will be responsible for your transportation in the US. If you need a ride to the airport please contact Atisha to coordinate your ride.
- Remember to bring your passport.
- For carry on luggage: Airport security only allows you to bring liquids on board if they are in a 3oz container or smaller. Any liquids larger than 3oz will be remove from your carry on luggage.
- Cell phones: if you choose to use your cell phone you can get an international plan added during your travels. Wi-fi will be available at the hotel.

## **What to Bring:**

Clothing: Weather will be hot and wet in Haiti. Long shorts or pants will be great for

Haiti. You will also be receiving a Change T-Shirt that you can wear in Haiti. Good sneakers that can get dirty. We will be lodging at a hotel so please have appropriate sleeping attire and lounge clothing during your stay.

Necessities: Towels will be provided at the hotel. You are welcome to bring your own if you feel more comfortable. Please remember your personal hygiene items and shower shoes. Bug spray, wet wipes and a poncho will be provided for you for our time in Haiti should you need them. You will need to have hand sanitizers and toilet wipes in your backpack.

Luggage: pack as light as possible. You are allowed bring two carry on items on the plane; One small carryon to go under the seat and one carryon to go overhead. (Example: back pack to go under the seat and small roller bag to go in overhead) We will be checking all of the crafts and instruments under, so please avoid bringing large luggage that will need to be checked under.

### **Things to Know:**

What to expect/what is expected?

Each time we take a trip to Haiti our team members are excited but unsure what to expect. Haiti is the poorest country in the Americas and it has experienced political violence throughout its history. The economy is still recovering from the massive earthquake in 2010. Because of the country's challenges we have adopted Orphelinat Chretien de Petite Olace Cazeau Orphanage. Our orphanage has 75 children between the ages of 6 and 17. Many of these children are there because their parents could not take care of them. The orphanage has one house mother, Sonia, and some support staff for cooking and laundry. We know it's difficult for one person to give 75 children individual care and attention so during our trips to Haiti we are expected to supply as much love and care as we can. We encourage you to hug the children, engage in activities with them, play games, and sing.
