

ABANDON SHIP Small Group Discussion Guide

Main Idea:

Following Jesus requires *Holy Abandonment*—the willingness to leave behind comfort, control, and comparison for the sake of calling.

Key Quotes to Discuss:

- "What some people call comfort has become their cage."
- "Control is the illusion that you can engineer outcomes."
- "Comparison turns calling into competition."
- "Many want fish in their boat without Jesus in their boat."

Icebreaker:

What's the most difficult thing you've ever had to give up in order to move forward in life?

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Why do you think comfort can become a "cage" in our walk with God?
- 2. In what ways do you try to maintain control instead of surrendering to Christ?
- 3. How does comparison show up in your everyday life (work, family, social media)?
- 4. Why do you think Jesus asked Peter to leave something he was already good at (fishing) for something new (discipleship)?
- 5. What might God be asking you to abandon in this season and what new doors could that open?

Closing Challenge:

Identify one area of **comfort, control, or comparison** you need to abandon this week. Share it with your group and pray for one another to take that step of holy abandonment.
