**Key Takeaways**

⇒ **Three Ways To Handle Disappointment:**

- Culture's Way is to use pleasure as a painkiller to numb the pain; or use force to try to fix what God may be requiring you to face.
- The Church's way is to shout through it but refuse to sit with it. It is to praise and never process.
- The King's way is to feel it, face it, and faith it.

⇒ **Four Things Lost When We Lose Spiritual Sight:**

- Speed - Vision clarity leads to decision clarity
- Sanity - How we see affects our emotional peace
- Safety - Spiritual sight helps us discern threats and opportunities
- Stability - Clear vision helps us stay firm in storms

⇒ **Four Solutions That Require Submission (Trust):**

- What God Was Going To Do
- The Way God Was Going To Do It
- Where God Was Going To Do It
- When God Was Going To Do It

**Personal Reflection**

1. Which of the four losses (speed, sanity, safety, stability) resonates most with your current season? How has a loss of spiritual vision affected this area?
2. Jesus used mud (something that seemed to make things worse) as part of His strategy. Have you experienced a season where God's strategy felt like He was making things worse before making them better? How did you respond?
3. What unanswered question are you currently holding? How is your peace level related to not having that answer? What would it look like to trust God without getting that answer?
4. God gives strategy, not always explanation. Is there a "mud moment" you're currently in—something that doesn't make sense but might be God's instrument? How can this group pray for you to trust the process?
5. How does knowing that God orders both your path and your pace change how you view your current season?
